Join us in our 8th annual Britton Fund Ride.

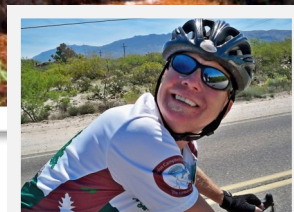
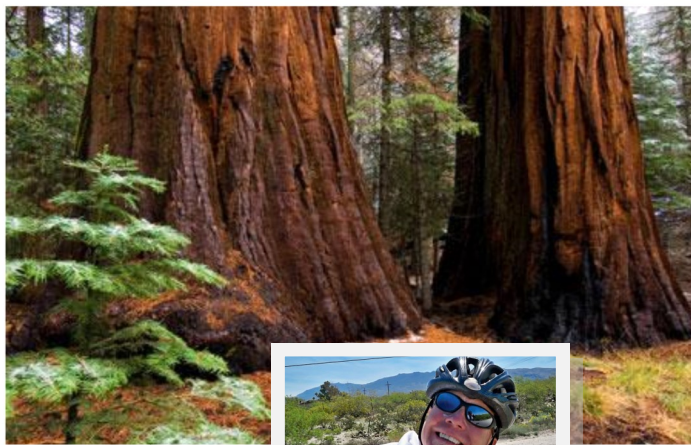
Your support of a Britton Fund Ride cyclist will make a significant difference in the well-being of our Urban Forest and help to raise funds for tree research in the Western region.
